• **TRAINING**

--**HANDGUN SAFETY CLASSES** - NR&PC conducts handgun safety classes to qualify handgun owners for Concealed Carry Permits in the States of Oregon and Utah. The Utah permit is recognized by more than 28 states and is useful for persons traveling in those states. Below is the flyer advertising the January, 2010 Class:

Subsequent classes are planned on the third Saturday of the months of April, July and October in 2010.

The course includes Responsible Use; Handgun Safety; Managing an Encounter; Basic Handgun Operation; Suitable Ammunition; Shooting Fundamentals; Concealed Carry Methods; Federal, State and Local Laws; Live Fire Exercise.

Upon class completion the student will receive a Certification of Handgun Safety that is used for applying for the actual Concealed Carry Permit. Procedures for applying vary in each jurisdiction. For the Oregon Concealed Handgun License (CHL), the applicant is to follow local procedures of the Sheriff in the county of residence. For the Utah Concealed Firearm Permit (CFP), the applicant will receive a packet of information that includes a photograph and fingerprints that are taken during class break times. --**FIRST AID CLASSES**

--**NRA INSTRUCTOR CLASSES**

Michael Jones will be teaching two NRA Instructor courses for Newberg Rifle and Pistol Club at the Gibbs Community Center. The NRA Basic Instructor course on January 30 is the first requirement for certification as an NRA Instructor. Students will learn teaching techniques and skills to organize and present courses in the NRA Basic Firearm Training Program. The NRA Basic Pistol Instructor class held on February 6 & 7 includes a live-fire qualification with pistol and revolver. This course presents Basic Pistol and FIRST Steps Pistol Course lesson plans and how to effectively teach them using in-class exercises. Successful completion of the NRA Basic Instructor course and the NRA Basic Pistol Instructor course are prerequisites for persons interested in being certified to teach the Utah concealed handgun course. - **LEAGUE & POSTAL MATCHES**

The **Willamette Valley Pistol League** (WVPL) began with NR&PC shooters attending its first match at Albany Rifle & Pistol Club on 15 Nov 2009. The NRPC team will compete in league shooting 17 Jan 2010 at NRPC, 21 Feb 2010 at Portland Rifle & Pistol, and 14 Mar 2010 at Four Corners Rod & Gun. The 2010 Postal Match registration period has ended. Practice and scoring is being done at the scheduled range use evenings (see NR&PC SCHEDULED SHOOTING below).

- **NR&PC WEEKLY SCHEDULED SHOOTING**

(Note: Special NRPC and Gibbs Community Club (GCC) events occasionally have preemptory use on otherwise scheduled shooting times. Be sure to check the Club calendar on the Club web site, www.nrpc.net).

Monday – League Pistol Team practice and Postal Match scoring (Pistols only) 6:30 – 9:00 PM

Tuesday (except on Club Meeting evenings)– Postal Match practice and scoring (Rifles only)–7:00 – 9:00 PM

Wednesday – Open small bore rifle (.22 cal) 7:00 – 9:00 PM

Thursday – Open pistol, any caliber up to 44 magnum and .45 cal. Certain High Power/velocity handguns such as .460 S&W, 500 S&W, and others chambered for primarily rifle calibers i.e. 45-70, are not permitted. Check with the Range Officer in charge before shooting.

- **OTHER CLUB SERVICES**

Hunter Education- NR&PC sponsors one class per year, usually in the spring. Other local instructors may use the facilities at various times. 4-H Club – Mike Billings has brought a local 4-h club to shoot at our facility and will be continuing with that in the coming months. Their shooting is held in conjunction with the Wednesday evening open shooting time.

Retired Police Officers (RPO) Annual Qualifying – One or two times each year the RPOs use our facility. Their schedule is usually on a “fit-in” basis.

- **SERVICE RIFLE MATCHES AND INFORMAL RIFLE SHOOTING**

Organized Service Rifle or CMP Style matches for 2010 may be held in conjunction with Chehalem Valley Sportsman Club’s (CVSC) program. Their program and schedule for 2010 has not yet been set. Saturday, January 16th, from 9:00 a.m. to mid afternoon is the date and time for our CHL handgun class. The place is Gibbs Community Center located at the intersection of Bell & Quarry roads northeast of Newberg. Please bring a sack lunch.

Keep in mind that the law restricts the issuance of permits to carry licensed handgun to those 21 years or older and have no criminal record or mental illness. Due to the content of the course **no person under 21 will be allowed in during the class.**

If you have a handgun, please bring it UNLOADED to the inspection table at our range. Also bring one fifty-round box of fresh commercial ammunition of the caliber of your weapon. If you do not have a handgun you are welcome, but call us to make arrangements before going through the class.

You will have an experienced teaching team. The course will strongly stress **HANDGUN SAFETY.**

\$80 Utah only (valid in more than 28 states)
